Groww IPO Charges Up New Deal Activities in Wealthtech Startups

Investment deals heating in startups building digital platforms for stock broking, wealth mgmt

Bengaluru: With wealthtech startups growing as the largest stock broking in India, going public, private market investment sentiments are turning buoyant. A bundle of investment deals are heating in startups which are building digital platforms to offer services across stock broking, wealth management and mutual fund distribution to accredited people with knowledge of the matter. AssePlus, a Chennai-based startup which helps mutual fund distributors acquire their businesses, is looking to secure \$18 million in fresh funding round led by Nexus Venture Partners, said the people. The deal is being stretched year after year. AssePlus secured around \$1 million from Eight Roads Ventures and existing investor Zeroh-backed Rainmaker. InCred is another major investor in AssePlus. "The deal could catapult AssePlus' valuation to around \$100 million," said one of the persons, who did not wish to be identified. Bengaluru-based

Capital could join the round. "Sahi is in talks to raise around \$10-15 million in this round. However, the deal has not been finalized yet," said another person.

Responding to E's queries, Vaz said that the information is incorrect. Queries emailed to the other founders and investors went unanswered.

Another Bengaluru-based wealth player PowerUpMoney is also looking for fresh funding, according to people in the know. The startup,

which was spun out of UniCards, is in discussions with Peak XV Partners to raise \$8-10 million, they said.

"The firm is developing a platform that links credit building tools with investment management, an emerging intersection drawing early investor attention," said one of the persons. Founded by UniCards cofounder Prateek Jindal, PowerUpMoney has a registered investment advisory licence and is building a mutual fund advisory platform, betting on the market doubling to \$10 million investors over the next few years.

StableMoney which is building an online platform for fixed income investment products such as fixed deposits and bonds, is in talks with Peak XV Partners to close a \$20-25 million fresh funding round.

Despite the flurry of activity, several investors said sentiment across wealthtech remains tied to Groww's upcoming IPO, expected to serve as a bellwether for the sector. "Everyone is waiting to see where Groww gets priced," said one investor involved in the deals.

Noose Tightens, US Issues Demand for \$100K H-1B Fee

RFEs demanding the H-1B fee are being issued even where it isn't warranted, impacting Indians: Experts

Bengaluru: The US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) has begun issuing requests for evidence (RFEs) demanding payment of the \$100,000 H-1B fee amid tightening scrutiny around immigration in the region, according to people familiar with the matter. The development follows the presidential proclamation in September imposing a \$100,000 fee for fresh H-1B petitions filed by candidates outside of the US and those requiring consular processing after September 8. The USCIS issues an RFE when an immigration officer believes there isn't enough evidence to approve the case. Multiple immigration experts told ET that they are beginning to see RFEs, even in cases where the fee is not warranted due to lack of clarity over who is subject to the \$100,000 fee, adding that this could result in more lawsuits. Indians, who account for 70% of the H-1B visas issued, are the most impacted by this development.

'Our Mission is to Empower the 99% Who Can't Code'

Lovable cofounder says co looks to bridge the gap between ideas & execution via simple descriptions

Mountain View: Artificial intelligence (AI) startup Lovable is positioning itself differently in the crowded coding-assist segment; instead of targeting software engineers, it is focusing on people with little or no technical background. Founded in 2023, the startup allows users to describe what they want in simple language, like a landing page, dashboard or prototype, and lets the platform generate code in real time.

"Most of the current players assume you are already a developer," Fabian Hedin, Lovable's cofounder and chief technology officer, told ET in an interview on the sidelines of an AI event at tech firm Google's headquarters in Mountain View, California. "Our product is designed for people who have ideas but not coding skills. You just describe your vision, and within minutes, something tangible is built for you," he said.

Lovable's approach differs from the growing pack of AI-powered coding assistants, from Microsoft's GitHub Copilot and Cursor to Replit. While these products are built to help programmers work faster, Lovable aims at a much wider base—people with no technical background. "It's a very obvious thing to apply AI to empower developers has always been to let the 99% who cannot code build the same things as software developers. We want to make software creation as accessible as writing a document or recording a video."

Lovable launched its current version in November 2024, after experiencing a period of rapid growth. The market for AI-assisted coding, popularly called "vibe coding", is becoming one of the most active corners of the startup ecosystem. Larger technology firms such as OpenAI and Google are also investing in AI-powered application layer, potentially overlapping with smaller startups that depend on their models. Hedin says Lovable was comfortable operating at the application layer rather than trying to build foundation models.

India PCB Manufacturing Set to Hit \$14B by 2030: Report

Bengaluru: Domestic manufacturing of printed circuit boards (PCBs) is projected to reach nearly \$14 billion by 2030, close to 10% of the government's \$150 billion electronics components manufacturing target, said an Electronic Industries Association of India (EIAI) survey report.

Policy reforms and local demand are unlocking opportunities for India's PCB sector, long dominated by imports, it said. Despite the surge in demand, India imported nearly 98% of its requirement of bare PCBs in 2024-25, worth \$3.7 billion out of the total demand of \$4.2 billion. Locally manufactured bare PCBs currently amount to only \$800 million, but domestic sourcing has seen a remarkable CAGR of 27.3% over the past five years, outpacing previous periods.

Raghu Panicker, chief ETO, Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme (ECMS) sub-multi-layer PCBs, HDI PCBs, camera module sub-assemblies, laminates and polypropylene film. Four projects from the Kaynes Group, and one project each from Syrma Group, Acon Circuits of Amber Group and SRP Limited have been approved. These units will be established across Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh.

The growth is fuelled by strong domestic demand from the consumer electronics and electric vehicle sectors, favourable government initiatives such as Make-in-India, ECMS and Production Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes, and a shift in demand from imported bare PCBs which is benefiting local manufacturers, Panicker said.

3 dead in crash as driver loses control trying to save wild boar

Palakkad: Three young men were killed and three others injured after the driver lost control of their car and crashed into a tree at Kallinj junction near Kodumba in Kerala's Palakkad late on Saturday night. The accident took place when the driver swerved to avoid a wild animal — likely a wild boar — on the road, the survivors told police.

Police identified the deceased as Rohan Ranjith, 24, Rohan Santhosh, 22, and Sanooj, 19 — all residents of Palakkad. The injured — Rishi, 24, Jithin, 21, and Adithyan, 23 — were taken to hospital. Their injuries are non-fatal, police said. The accident occurred

around 11pm when the group was returning from Chittoor. Police said the driver swerved to avoid hitting a wild boar that suddenly crossed the road, causing the vehicle to skid off the road and crash into a tree in a nearby field. The vehicle was completely destroyed in the impact, police said.

A K Saseendran, minister for forests and wildlife protection, and K Krishnakutty, electricity minister, condoled the deaths and called the incident as "unfortunate". "If it is confirmed the accident was caused by boars, forest department will ensure compensation and necessary support," Saseendran said. TNN & AGENCIES

Asia Cup gold medallist kayaker run over by truck

Bhopal: Two Indian Navy kayakers, including an Asia Cup gold medallist, were killed after a speeding truck rammed into their motorcycle and dragged it for nearly 20 metres in Bhopal early Sunday, reports Ramendra Singh.

The deceased — chief petty officer Vishnu Raghunathan, 27, and petty officer Ananth Krishnan, 18, both from Kerala — were in Bhopal for a training camp with their naval unit. Raghunathan had won the gold medal in the 1000m K-2 category at the 2024 Asia Cup in Hong Kong and earlier secured a bronze at an open international championship held in Bhopal in 2019.

Rohit Nagar SHO said the accident occurred near Mubarakpur toll plaza between 2.30am and 3am. The truck sped away after the collision. Police said toll booth records and CCTV footage are being examined to identify and trace the truck and its driver.

At 144%, big jump in Somalia tourist arrivals

Up From 5,044 In 2019 To 12,320 In 2024


New Delhi: India has seen its highest foreign tourist arrival (FTA) growth in percentage terms from Somalia between pre-Covid 2019 and 2024. At over 144%, the poor east African country is the only one to register a triple digit growth rate, surging from 5,044 in 2019 to 12,320 in 2024, according to Union tourism ministry data.

Besides this surprise entry, the other countries in the top five by growth rate are Cambodia (81%), Kazakhstan (72%), Vietnam (61%) and Bhutan (47%). Somalia's growth rate would have been higher had it not seen its tourists dip from 16,607 in 2023 to 12,320 in 2024.

India had 99.5 lakh FTAs in CY (calendar year) 2024, less than the pre-Covid all-time high of almost 1.1 crore. The travel industry expects to breach pre-Covid numbers either this year or latest by early next year with "continued focus on visas, infrastructure, and global promotion", according to Indian Association of Tour Operators (IATO) president Ravi Gosain.

"India's inbound tourism is witnessing a better rebound this season. Most of our member operators are reporting 10%-15% higher arrivals than last year, driven by renewed interest from North America, Europe, West Asia and South-

east Asia. The encouraging part is the quality of travel with longer stays, higher per-capita spending, and growing preference for experiential and sustainable tourism products," Gosain said.

Preliminary data and trade feedback indicate that CY 2025 could see 1-1.05 crore FTAs compared to 1.09 crore in 2019. With "continued policy support, especially easier visas and India's global positioning, we are on track to surpass 2019 inbound volume by 2026," Gosain added.

While India is slowly inching up to pre-pandemic levels, the ministry data show FTA recovery is different across regions. Only the Americas (US and Canada) have surpassed 2019 levels.

"Asia and the Pacific remained the largest source region, accounting for 43% of total FTAs in 2024 (42.8 lakh arrivals), according to the data. However, this represents a 22.6% decline from 2019, mainly due to continued decline from South Asia (minus 28.6%) and North-East Asia (minus 49.4%). Oceania surpassed its 2019 level by 38.2%, reflecting strong recovery led by countries like Australia and New Zealand, the ministry said.

Europe contributed 26.7% to FTAs in 2024 (26.6 lakh) and was just 3.2% lower than 2019 levels. The Americas showed impressive recovery and growth with 23.7 lakh arrivals in 2024. The region recorded a 20.8% growth over 2019 and constituted 23.8% of total FTAs, the ministry said.

Africa accounted for 3.4% of FTAs in 2024, with near-complete recovery to 2019 levels. West Asia, contributing 2.97% to India's FTAs in 2024, witnessed a decline of 14.1% over 2019, the ministry said.

The rape survivor had come to Agra to appear in court in connection with the gang-rape case against three men in Etawah. Advocate Jitendra Singh, who, she said, approached her the same day, claimed he could mediate a settlement with the other accused. He later booked a room for her at a city hotel, saying it was too late for her to return home.

The woman told police that Singh initially left her in the hotel room but returned later that night with dinner and, under the pretext of discussing the case, allegedly raped her. She added that though he locked the door from inside and prevented her from leaving, she managed to slip out under the pretext of getting water and hid inside the hotel until he left. She approached police the following morning and filed a complaint, based on which an FIR was registered under BNS section 64(1) (rape).

Investigators visited the hotel, collected CCTV footage and visitor records, and launched a manhunt to trace Singh. A forensic team examined the room, and officials said both digital and physical evidence were being preserved. Police also recovered entries from the hotel's visitor register and CCTV footage showing Singh and the woman entering the premises together.

Agra DCP (city) Sayed Ali Abbar said, "During a raid at the accused's house, he jumped from a neighbour's roof and fractured both legs. He was admitted to SN Medical College. We secured his remand Saturday and produced him before the court. He has been sent to judicial custody. The woman was sent for a medical examination."
